# **ENTRY and JUDGING SPECIFICATIONS:**

Hunts not recognized or registered with the Masters of Foxhounds Association are ineligible to show at the Southern Hound Show.

Hounds registered in the MFHA Stud book belonging to non MFHA hunts are NOT eligible to show at the Southern Hound Show.

The former Grand Champions of the show may not be shown in any class that qualifies for a championship (except the Two Couples classes).

Except for unentered hounds, all entries must have hunted fairly the previous season with the pack entering them to show. Each Hunt may enter as many hounds as they like and show up to 3 entries in each class. Hounds will be exhibited loose and on a lead. Natural posing, with one person holding the lead and a second person with a biscuit in front of the hound(s) is encouraged.

Substitutions may be made at any time at the secretary's desk as long as the hound is named on the entry form and the entry fee is paid before the hound is shown.

Any dog shown in any class must have two testicles or a vet certificate stating that the hound had two testicles prior to one's removal for cause. Hounds drafted from other hunts may be shown in any class. No trophy or ribbon will be given in any class failing to have entries from at least two different Hunts. In the Two Couple Classes hounds need not be named. In Stallion Hound with Get and Brood Bitch with Produce classes, only the Stallion and Brood Bitch need to be named. White kennel coats and hunt caps or bowlers must be worn while showing hounds. Logos and/or arm bands are permitted.

#### EXCEPT IN CLASS 23 GRAND CHAMPION OF SHOW, THE HOUND THAT PLACED SECOND IN THE CLASS THAT QUALIFIED THE CHAMPION HOUND FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP MAY COMPETE FOR THE RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP.

All trophies are perpetual, and winners assume responsibility for replacement should it be lost, stolen or damaged.

In couples classes please list the two hounds by couple.

**ENTRY FEES:** <u>Must be paid when entries are made</u>. \$8.00 per hound (or entry) per class. Kennels \$25.00 (including bedding). Bring feed and water buckets/troughs - maximum 10 hounds per kennel. No equipment kennels are available.

FOOD AND FUN: There will be a Friday night exhibitors' party on the show grounds at 6:30. Saturday there will be tented tables for 8 at ring side, including lunch and wine. Saturday immediately after the show, there will be a come as you are dinner at Live Oak Main House, dinner served at 6:30. The dinners Friday and Saturday nights as well as Saturday lunch under the ring side tent are \$40 per person per event which include an open bar. <u>Reservations for both dinners and lunch are only by prepaid reservation.</u> Please pay at the time entries are sent in and list all attending by name.

DURING THE LUNCH, THERE WILL BE A JUNIOR HANDLERS CLASS AS WELL AS A JUNIOR HAT CONTEST (FOR THOSE 18 YEARS AND UNDER) AND A LADIES HAT CONTEST (FOR THOSE 19 YEARS AND OLDER) WITH PRIZES IN EACH DIVISION.

# **CONDITIONS FOR THE SOUTHERN HOUND SHOW**

CANINE BRUCELLOSIS: Bitches that have aborted or whelped within two months, are pregnant or in season must not be brought to the show nor will they be allowed on the show grounds in crates, vehicles, etc. DOGS NOT SHOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

Any hunt with confirmed Leishmaniasis in their kennel must provide negative test results for each competing hound, from a licensed veterinarian, within 6 months of the show date.

LIABILITY: Neither the Southern Hound Show Committee nor anyone else connected with this show shall in any way be responsible or liable for theft, accident, death, or injury to hounds, equipment, exhibitors or spectators.

ELIGIBILITY: All hounds entered in this show must belong to a Pack recognized or registered with the Masters of Foxhound Association and be in the MFHA stud book or eligible for acceptance by the Keeper of the Stud Book if whelped since December 1, 2023. <u>All Packs entering must be current with their Hound Show Membership in the MFHA.</u> A master exhibiting hounds in unentered classes certifies that it is fully intended to enter these hounds at the proper time.

CLASS NO. 18 TWO COUPLE OF BITCHES UNENTERED OR ENTERED. Different types may be included in one entry.

CLASS NO. 19 CHAMPION TWO COUPLE

CLASS NO. 20 BROOD BITCH WITH THREE OF HER PRODUCE

CLASS NO. 21 CHAMPION BITCH HOUND

The Fox River Valley Trophy, presented in 2007 by Mr. P. A. Leahy MFH and Mrs. Leahy. Open only to the winners of Classes 11, 12, 14, 15 and 17. THE HOUND THAT PLACED SECOND IN THE CLASS THAT QUALIFIED THE CHAMPION HOUND FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP MAY COMPETE FOR THE RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP.

### CLASS NO. 22 CHAMPION UNENTERED HOUND

The Bear Creek Hounds Trophy presented in 2007 by Mr. Hal V. Barry MFH and Mrs. Barry. Open only to the winners of Classes 1, 2, 11 and 12. THE HOUND THAT PLACED SECOND IN THE CLASS THAT QUALIFIED THE CHAMPION HOUND FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP MAY COMPETE FOR THE RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP.

CLASS NO. 23 GRAND CHAMPION OF SHOW

The Live Oak Hostess '97 Trophy, presented by Mr. and Mrs. C. Martin Wood III, jt MFH. Open <u>only</u> to the winners of Classes 10 and 21. A Reserve Grand Championship ribbon will also be awarded.

CLASS NO. 24 JUNIOR HANDLERS CLASS

Open to Juniors 16 and under associated with exhibiting packs. To be judged on the handling and presentation of the foxhound. One handler per hound. SHOWN DURING THE LUNCH BREAK

# **DIRECTIONS to 676 LIVE OAK LANE, MONTICELLO FL 32344**

#### **FRIDAY NIGHT PARTY AND SOUTHERN HOUND SHOW** <u>TO LIVE OAK PLANTATION FROM THOMASVILLE, GEORGIA</u> (23 minutes): South on US 19. Just past the 5-mile marker, turn left on Reichertville Road. Go down Reichertville Road 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> miles to stop sign at the intersection with GA 33. Turn right on GA 33. Turn immediately left through two short white posts flanked by oak trees. Look for LIVE OAK hanging sign with fox mask and crossed whips. Follow driveway to the fork. The right-hand fork takes you along the fence line to the show grounds.

### SATURDAY NIGHT PARTY AT LIVE OAK MAIN HOUSE

Immediately following the Show by prior reservation (*Come as you are*) Follow the crowd around the hill on the farm road and park in the field in front of the house.
