Whipper In/Kennelperson/Groom

Toronto and North York Hunt requires a whipper-in/kennel person/groom

- Full time position reporting directly to the Huntsman Antony Gaylard and indirectly reporting to Andy Bite MFH.
- Riding and/or non-riding applicants considered
- Accommodation on site provided
- Must be comfortable working with hounds and horses
- Located at TNYH Kennels in Mulmur, Ontario (just outside of the town of Creemore, 1.5 hours north of Toronto)
- Valid drivers licence required
- Competitive salary and vacation

Professional Whipper-In/Kennelperson/Groom Duties shall include the following:

- 1. Whipping-in (either by road vehicle or horseback), assistance with training and caring for the Hunt's hounds and horses under the direction of the Huntsman.
- 2. Care and maintenance of hounds with Huntsman including feeding/watering and kennel cleaning and washing.
- 3. Walking and exercising hounds out regularly when not hunting under the direction of the Huntsman.
- 4. Provide backup to the Huntsman when the Huntsman is on vacation or absent from duties
- 5. Care and maintenance of horses and preparation of horses for hunting and exercise.
- 6. Assisting with the maintenance of fixtures and trails as directed by the Huntsman.
- 7. Learn the "hunt country". Provide guidance and training to amateur hunt staff as required.
- 8. Attending on hunting days, on time, properly attired, with a fit horse and hounds, prepared to give the best sport possible.
- 9. Care and maintenance the TNYH property including the grounds, yards and driveways, the stables, the kennels and the apartment neat, clean, tidy and in good repair.
- 10.Maintaining positive relations and being courteous and professional to all members of the Hunt, visitors, guests, landowners and other interfaces and refraining from using improper language in front of the field.
- 11.Attend various TNYH functions and hound shows as requested.
- 12. Other miscellaneous duties as assigned by the Huntsman.
